**Genesis 3:9-15** We read of God's confrontation with Adam and Eve following their fall into sin. God calls them to acknowledge and confess their sin, but also in love promises a Savior who will pay their debt for them. Satan will be crushed by the Seed of the woman, the Messiah, the Christ.

*9 Then the Lord God called to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?"*

*10 So he said, "I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself." 11 And He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?" 12 Then the man said, "The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate." 13 And the Lord God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate." 14 So the Lord God said to the serpent: "Because you have done this, You are cursed more than all cattle, And more than every beast of the field; On your belly you shall go, And you shall eat dust All the days of your life. 15 And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel."*
