Scripture Readings:

Isaiah 35

In the previous chapter Isaiah depicted the desolation of Edom, a country to the southeast of Israel. In contrast, chapter 35 illustrates the LORD'S mercy and blessings upon Israel. These gifts included many miraculous signs and healings, a prophecy of the coming Messiah. But the greatest blessing is the ability to trek the Highway of Holiness, God's path toward heaven. This right is given to the redeemed ones, those who are ransomed by Christ's blood and believe in this promise by faith. What a tremendous example of God's grace, not just for the Old Testament faithful, but for you and me as well.

1 The wilderness and the wasteland shall be glad for them, And the desert shall rejoice and blossom as the rose; 2 It shall blossom abundantly and rejoice, Even with joy and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, The excellence of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the glory of the LORD, The excellency of our God. 3 Strengthen the weak hands, And make firm the

feeble knees. 4 Say to those who are fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear! Behold, your God will come with vengeance, With the recompense of God; He will come and save you." 5 Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, And the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. 6 Then the lame shall leap like a deer, And the tongue of the dumb sing. For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, And streams in the desert. 7 The parched ground shall become a pool, And the thirsty land springs of water; In the habitation of jackals, where each lay, There shall be grass with reeds and rushes. 8 A highway shall be there, and a road, And it shall be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, But it shall be for others. Whoever walks the road, although a fool, Shall not go astray. 9 No lion shall be there, Nor shall any ravenous beast go up on it; It shall not be found there. But the redeemed shall walk there, 10 And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, And come to Zion with singing, With everlasting joy on their heads. They shall obtain joy and gladness, And sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

Philippians 4:1-9

This chapter records Paul's final thoughts to the congregation in Philippi. He encourages them to remember the things which they were taught. We have received the same blessings from our Lord. Let us continually remember to rejoice in what God has given us and meditate on those things which are pleasing in His sight. But as Paul highlights in verse 7, the peace of God given through Christ Jesus is of greatest importance. This is the very peace which we meditate upon during the Advent season.

1 Therefore, my beloved and longed-for brethren, my joy and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, beloved. 2 I implore Euodia and I implore Syntyche to be of the same mind in the Lord. 3 And I urge you also, true companion, help these women who labored with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the Book of Life. 4 Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice! 5 Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord is at hand. 6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. 8 Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. 9 The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.

WELL UPDATE:

Bethke Plumbing will be out this Tuesday to dig up the area between the garage and the well. At that time they will turn the water off to the house and will pressure test the line to confirm the section of pipe that is leaking. It is possible (but unlikely) that the leak is close to the well and it could be repaired at that time. If that is the case, our cost will be quite a bit less. If the leak is not visible at that time, the hole will be covered until Intercon can come and bore the new line from the basement (Wednesday or Thursday). Once a new line is run, it will be connected to the well that day and the job should be finished. If all goes as planned right now, the job should be complete by next Thursday. There will be a brief interruption to the water supply to the parsonage Tuesday during the pressure test, and then again while connecting the new line to the well.

2 And when John had heard in prison about the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples 3 and said to Him, "Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?" 4 Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things which you hear and see: 5 The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them. 6 And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me." 7 As they departed, Jesus began to say to the multitudes concerning John: "What did you go out into the wilderness to see?
