



Scripture Readings:

Psalm 103:10-19

David sings of God's amazing grace to us sinners. He has not dealt with us according to our sins, but according to His great compassionate love. He is an everlasting Father to us in His kindness and mercy.

10 He has not dealt with us according to our sins, Nor punished us according to our iniquities. 11 For as the heavens are high above the earth, So great is His mercy toward those who fear Him; 12 As far as the east is from the west, So far has He removed our transgressions from us. 13 As a father pities his children, So the Lord pities those who fear Him. 14 For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust. 15 As for man, his days are like grass; As a flower of the field, so he flourishes. 16 For the wind passes over it, and it is gone, And its place remembers it no more. 17 But the mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting On those who fear Him, And His righteousness to children's children, 18 To such as keep His covenant, And to those who remember His commandments to do them. 19 The Lord has established His throne in heaven, And His kingdom rules over all.

Hebrews 10:5-10

The book of Hebrews clearly points to Christ's sacrifice of His body as the chief purpose of His coming into this world, in the flesh. It was completely sufficient to take away the sins of all people. By this sacrifice the Savior acted in obedience to His Father's will and loving as a sacrificial Father loves.

5 Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me. 6 In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure. 7 Then I said, 'Behold, I have come— In the volume of the book it is written of Me— To do Your will, O God.' "8 Previously saying, "Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings, and offerings for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure in them" (which are offered according to the law), 9 then He said, "Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God." He takes away the first that He may establish the second. 10 By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

John 1:1-14

The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. The Son came from the Father full of grace and truth, and brought the light of God's salvation into this world of darkness.
