### **Deuteronomy 34:1-12**

Today we celebrate Jesus’ transfiguration. Three disciples went with Jesus up a mountain and there saw Jesus shining in the glory that was His as true God. He spoke with two glorified saints of the Old Testament—Moses and Elijah. Our Old Testament reading tells us how

Moses died and was buried. There was not another prophet like him. The LORD knew him face to face!

*34 Then Moses went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, to the top of Pisgah, which is across from Jericho. And the Lord showed him all the land of Gilead as far as Dan, 2 all Naphtali and the land of Ephraim and Manasseh, all the land of Judah as far as the Western Sea, 3 the South, and the plain of the Valley of Jericho, the city of palm trees, as far as Zoar. 4 Then the Lord said to him, "This is the land of which I swore to give Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying, 'I will give it to your descendants.' I have caused you to see it with your eyes, but you shall not cross over there." 5 So Moses the servant of the Lord died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the Lord. 6 And He buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, opposite Beth Peor; but no one knows his grave to this day. 7 Moses was one hundred and twenty years old when he died. His eyes were not dim nor his natural vigor diminished. 8 And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab thirty days. So the days of weeping and mourning for Moses ended. 9 Now Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands on him; so the children of Israel heeded him, and did as the Lord had commanded Moses. 10 But since then there has not arisen in Israel a prophet like Moses, whom the Lord knew face to face, 11 in all the signs and wonders which the Lord sent him to do in the land of Egypt, before Pharaoh, before all his servants, and in all his land, 12 and by all that mighty power and all the great terror which Moses performed in the sight of all Israel..*

## **Luke 9:28-36**

Peter, James, and John saw the glory Jesus has as the eternal Son of God. This was a glory not normally seen. They saw it only for a moment. Peter wished it could have continued forever. But it cannot here on earth. This glory can be shared only the way Moses and Elijah shared it during their life---through the Word! Now they have it eternally. It is important that we too hear the Word of our Savior, listen to Him speak to us so that some day we too will eternally share in that same full-blown glory of eternity. While the Transfiguration

### **ANNUAL MEETING REPORT:**

16 voters attended. Received Tyler Greene as a voting member. Miriam Bernthal was released from our call to be our pre-school teacher since we did not open our pre-school. A special call meeting to call again for the fall will be held soon. Recommendation was made to allow the Packer's Youth Football camp the use our facility during the week of June 11-15. Treasurer reported offerings for 2017 were \$ 118,180 which was \$ 2,100 less than what was spent. We have a surplus at the end of 2017 of almost \$ 4,000. Praise the Lord for His gifts of grace! Adopted the 2018 budget of \$121,500 about a 3% increase over last year's actual offerings. This includes a 4% raise for Pastor and an increase in CBP (Cooperative Budget

Plan) to the CLC. B.O.C.E. will initiate advertising for our pre-school in early February with an anticipated opening of our school Sept. 4. Elections: Joel Albrecht, Caleb Meyer, Tim Schaser elected to the Church Council. Matt Schaser elected to the B.O.C.E. Pastor's housing allowance was again set at \$ 18,000. Our next Quarterly Voters' Meeting is set for April 22nd

closes out the Epiphany season, it also prepares us for the Lenten season which begins this coming Ash Wednesday. The topic of Christ's conversation with Moses and Elijah was the death and fulfillment of our salvation which Jesus would accomplish in Jerusalem.

*28 Now it came to pass, about eight days after these sayings, that He took Peter, John, and James and went up on the mountain to pray. 29 As He prayed, the appearance of His face was altered, and His robe became white and glistening. 30 And behold, two men talked with Him, who were Moses and Elijah, 31 who appeared in glory and spoke of His decease which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. 32 But Peter and those with him were heavy with sleep; and when they were fully awake, they saw His glory and the two men who stood with Him. 33 Then it happened, as they were parting from Him, that Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be here; and let us make three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah"—not knowing what he said.*

*34 While he was saying this, a cloud came and overshadowed them; and they were fearful as they entered the cloud. 35 And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!" 36 When the voice had ceased, Jesus was found alone. But they kept quiet, and told no one in those days any of the things they had seen.*
