### Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14

Daniel’s vision is of the all-powerful God, the “Ancient of Days,” as He assembles the royal court for Judgment. The Lord Christ (“One like the Son of Man”) stands before the “Ancient of Days.” Jesus is given authority, glory and sovereign power. His rule is an everlasting one for His kingdom shall never end.

*“I watched till thrones were put in place, And the Ancient of Days was seated; His garment was white as snow, And the hair of His head was like pure wool. His throne was a fiery flame, Its wheels a burning fire; 10 A fiery stream issued And came forth from before Him. 
