INVITATION TO WORSHIP

P: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost.

C: Amen.

P: O Lord, do not be far from me;

C: **O my Strength, hasten to help me!**

P: Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of Your name;

C: **And deliver us, and provide atonement for our sins, for Your name's sake.**

P: God forbid that I should glory;

C: **Except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

P: In Him is salvation, life and resurrection from the dead;

C: **By Him we are redeemed and set at liberty.**

P: All we like sheep have gone astray;

C: **And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.**

P: God be merciful to us and bless us;

C: **And cause His face to shine upon us.**

P: Christ humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death

C: **Even the death of the cross.**

P: Therefore God also highly exalted Him;

C: **And given Him the name which is above every name,**

P: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow;

C: **Of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth.**

P: Hear our prayer, O Lord;

C: **And let our cry come unto You. Amen.**

CONFESSION OF SINS

P: This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners.

C: **If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**

ALL: **Have mercy upon us, O God, according to Your loving kindnesses; according to the multitude of Your tender-mercies, blot out my transgressions. Wash me completely from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sins. For I confess my transgressions; and my sin is ever before me. Against You, You only, have I sinned and done this evil in Your sight. Restore unto me the joy of Your salvation.**
