Scripture Readings:

Ephesians 2:13-18

Jesus is our Peace! He reconciles both Jew and Gentile to God by His sacrifice on the cross. He continues to preach about that Peace through His messengers to both those near and far.

But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity. And He came and preached peace to you who were afar off and to those who were near. For through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father.

John 20:19-23

The resurrected Jesus bestows peace upon His disciples and tells them to go out and in the power of the Holy Spirit proclaim that Good News of peace---sins forgiven.

Then, the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst, and said to them, "Peace be with you." When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you." And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

Luke 2:8-20

Sermon Theme:

Finding Peace in Our Struggles.
