WINDOWS FOR PARSONAGE:


ABC Home Specialists will be installing the parsonage windows the week of Aug. 29th. Siding will take place in late September or October.

Scripture Readings:

Zechariah 12:7-10

The prophecy of Zechariah directs the people, feeble and forsaken, to look to the Lord's only Son, the first-born Son. Seeing this Son in faith brings a spirit of grace and supplication and the strength to be like David, like God and like the Angel of the LORD (Jesus).

7 "The LORD will save the tents of Judah first, so that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem shall not become greater than that of Judah. 8 In that day the LORD will defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; the one who is feeble among them in that day shall be like David, and the house of David shall be like God, like the Angel of the LORD before them. 9 It shall be in that day that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem. 10 "And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.

Luke 9:18-24

Luke records the "opinion poll" taken by Jesus among His disciples regarding His identity. Peter's confession: "You are the Christ of God." Jesus confirms this confession with His clear prediction of His suffering, death and resurrection. He concludes with His instructions for following Him.

18 And it happened, as He was alone praying, that His disciples joined Him, and He asked them, saying, "Who do the crowds say that I am?" 19 So they answered and said, "John the Baptist, but some say Elijah; and others say that one of the old prophets has risen again." 20 He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter answered and said, "The Christ of God." 21 And He strictly warned and commanded them to tell this to no one, 22 saying, "The Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day." 23 Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. 24 For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it.
