### **Genesis 2:18-24**

It is God who created marriage, not man. Therefore God, not man, has the right to regulate and bless it. **GOD'S REGULATION:** One man and one woman, for a lifetime! **GOD'S BLESSINGS:** A lifetime helper suitable to each other.

*18 And the Lord God said, "It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him." 19 Out of the ground the Lord God*

formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name. 20 So Adam gave names to all cattle, to the birds of the air, and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a helper comparable to him. 21 And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place. 22 Then the rib which the Lord God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man. 23 And Adam said: "This is now bone of my bones And flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man." 24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

## **Ephesians 5:22-33**

God's Word to wives: Total, loving, selfless submission to your husband "as to the Lord." God's Word to husbands: Total, loving, selfless service to your wives "as Christ loved the Church and gave Himself up for her."

22 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. 24 Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything. 25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 26 that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, 27 that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. 28 So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. 29 For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the church. 30 For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones. 31 "For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." 32 This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church. 33 Nevertheless let each one of you in particular so love his own wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.


### **Passages concerning the Sixth Commandment:**

### **QUARTERLY VOTER'S MEETING REPORT:**

Received as members Ben & Robin Carstensen and daughters Charlotte and Violet by transfer from Messiah Lutheran - Eau Claire, WI

- Transferred Luke Schaser's membership to Messiah Lutheran - Eau Claire
- Moved to approve expenditure up to \$2,500 for Property Committee to either procure materials and utilize self-perform labor or work with a contractor to perform front parsonage drainage/leveling and back fellowship hall entrance work.
- Moved to delay the deck addition solution, for future consideration after Property Committee develops short and/or long term solution for door stoop maintenance.
- Moved to grant the Playground Equipment Replacement Committee permission to move forward with the purchase and placement, including grading/landscaping, of a play set with a budget of no more than \$3,500 from School Restart Savings Account.
- Moved to accept MG&E proposal for installation of 2 lights according to recommendation of Property Committee for 2 wooden poles at \$8.85/month and (2) 15,000 lumen HPS flood lights at \$17.70/month for a total of \$53.10/month.

## **Matthew 19:3-9**

God hates divorce! Man has the power and the ability but not the right to break a marriage bond. Unfaithfulness and desertion are the only God-allowable reasons for the "innocent" party to declare a marriage is broken. Not acceptable reasons by God---incompatibility; falling out of love; irreconcilable differences; no fault divorce, not getting along, etc.

*3 The Pharisees also came to Him, testing Him, and saying to Him, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for just any reason?" 4 And He answered and said to them, "Have you not read that He who made them at the beginning 'made them male and female,' 5 and said, 'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'? 6 So then, they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate." 7 They said to Him, "Why then did Moses command to give a certificate of divorce, and to put her away?" 8 He said to them, "Moses, because of the hardness of your hearts, permitted you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so. 9 And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery; and whoever marries her who is divorced commits adultery."*
