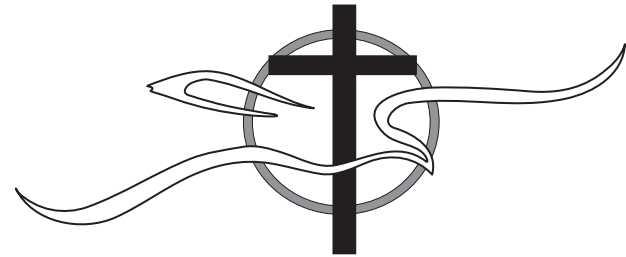

Deuteronomy 6:1-9

These words were spoken to Old Testament Israel, but we see their application for us today. We believe in one God—the LORD Jehovah! The words and works of this one God we are to tell our children and our children's children. We are to diligently teach them about their God and keep His Word before their eyes and hearts throughout the day.

“Now this is the commandment, and these are the statutes and judgments which the Lord your God has commanded to teach you, that you may observe them in the land which you are crossing over to possess, 2 that you may fear the Lord your God, to keep all His statutes and His commandments which I command you, you and your son and your grandson, all the days of your life, and that your days may be prolonged. 3 Therefore hear, O Israel, and be careful to observe it, that it may be well with you, and that you may multiply greatly as the Lord God of your fathers has promised you—‘a land flowing with milk and honey.’ 4 “Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one! 5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. 6 “And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. 8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

II Corinthians 13:11-14

In his final greeting at the end of his letter, the Apostle Paul focuses our attention on the special relationship we have with our God and our fellow Christians. We enjoy the comfort our God gives in forgiveness of sins; we find comfort in being at peace with God. This relationship we have with our Triune God brings about another special relationship that we have with our fellow Christians. A relationship of love, peace and harmony.
