II Corinthians 4:13-18

External troubles will come to those who live in opposition to Satan. Even though life is filled with hardships, we have the victory guaranteed through Jesus Christ. So we "fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen"—that is the "eternal glory" that awaits us.

13 And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore

...speak, 14 knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus will also raise us up with Jesus, and will present us with you. 15 For all things are for your sakes, that grace, having spread through the many, may cause thanksgiving to abound to the glory of God. 16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. 17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, 18 while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Mark 3:20-27

Jesus' victories over the demons (casting them out) are denounced by the teachers of the law as works done in league with the "prince of the demons." Jesus exposes the foolishness of such a teaching which would result in self-inflicted destruction of Satan's own kingdom. Rather, Jesus' victories over the forces of evil are the result of His superior power. He is the Promised Seed of the woman who has come to crush Satan!

20 Then the multitude came together again, so that they could not so much as eat bread. 21 But when His own people heard about this, they went out to lay hold of Him, for they said, "He is out of His mind." 22 And the scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, "He has Beelzebub," and, "By the ruler of the demons He casts out demons." 23 So He called them to Himself and said to them in parables: "How can Satan cast out Satan? 24 If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. 25 And if a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand. 26 And if Satan has risen up against himself, and is divided, he cannot stand, but has an end. 27 No one can enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man. And then he will plunder his house.
