### Scripture Readings:

#### John 16:5-11

Jesus foretells the coming of the "Counselor" the Holy Spirit to His disciples in the Upper Room on Maundy Thursday.

*5 "But now I go away to Him who sent Me, and none of you asks Me, 'Where are You going?' 6 But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. 7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage*

*that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. 8 And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 of sin, because they do not believe in Me; 10 of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; 11 of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.*

## **Acts 2:1-21**

The promised Counselor comes in a miraculous way upon the disciples and the curse of Babel is undone. The Gospel is spoken and heard in different languages so that the message of Jesus crucified and risen again can be spread to foreign lands.

*When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. 3 Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. 5 And there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men, from every nation under heaven. 6 And when this sound occurred, the multitude came together, and were confused, because everyone heard them speak in his own language. 7 Then they were all amazed and marveled, saying to one another, "Look, are not all these who speak Galileans? 8 And how is it that we hear, each in our own language in which we were born? 9 Parthians and Medes and Elamites, those dwelling in Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, 10 Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya adjoining Cyrene, visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, 11 Cretans and Arabs—we hear them speaking in our own tongues the wonderful works of God." 12 So they were all amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, "Whatever could this mean?" 13 Others mocking said, "They are full of new wine." 14 But Peter, standing up with the eleven, raised his voice and said to them, "Men of Judea and all who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and heed my words. 15 For these are not drunk, as you suppose, since it is only the third hour of the day. 16 But this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: 17 'And it shall*

come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams. 18 And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; And they shall prophesy. 19 I will show wonders in heaven above And signs in the earth beneath: Blood and fire and vapor of smoke. 20 The sun shall be turned into darkness, And the moon into blood, Before the coming of the great and awesome day of the Lord. 21 And it shall come to pass That whoever calls on the name of the Lord Shall be saved.'

**CLC CONVENTION POSTPONED:**

Due to the Covid 19 the CLC Convention that had been moved to July 30-Aug. 2 has been postponed and is rescheduled for 2021. Please read the letter below from CLC President Mike Eichstadt.

Dear brothers & sisters in Christ,

After consultation with CLC board chairmen and conference visitors, I have decided that due to the health concerns and other disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, it is necessary for us to postpone this summer's CLC Convention to June 2021. It would not be in the best interests of Christian love to ask pastors, teachers, and delegates from across the country to gather in Eau Claire at the end of July when there is so much uncertainty as to what the circumstances will be at that time. In order to carry out the blessed work the Lord has given us as faithfully as possible, we want to have good representation from all our congregations. We don't want anyone to feel uncomfortable about attending. We want to be able to direct our full attention to the work without the distractions of the current situation.

The CLC boards and Coordinating Council are still scheduled to meet in Eau Claire on June 8-10. Terms of elected board members and CLC officers which are ending this summer will be extended for a year. Other Convention work such as consideration of the Joint Statement will also be postponed until next June.

It is a great disappointment not to meet as a body to praise our Lord and Savior, renew fellowship ties with old acquaintances and meet new friends in Christ. But we can still remember one another in our prayers, support our joint work through our offerings, and receive Word and Sacrament with our local congregational families. The Lord reassures us that no matter where we are, whether our congregation is one of several CLC churches in an area or a far flung outpost, He knows us all and will keep us safe as His own.
