SCRIPTURE READING:

Acts 13:44-52

Two weeks ago we read the Apostle Paul's first sermon in Antioch of Pisidia. It has a great impact on the people. The next Sabbath almost the whole town (Jews and Gentiles) turned out to hear the Word of the Lord spoken by Paul. Instead of rejoicing over this, the Jews became jealous, because Paul was sharing the Good News with the Gentiles. Paul and Barnabas now turn to the Gentiles where their preaching is received with great joy.

On the next Sabbath almost the whole city came together to hear the word of God. But when the Jews saw the multitudes, they were filled with envy; and contradicting and blaspheming, they opposed the things spoken by Paul. Then Paul and Barnabas grew bold and said, "It was necessary that the word of God should be spoken to you first; but since you reject it, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, behold, we turn to the Gentiles. For so the Lord has commanded us: 'I have set you as a light to the Gentiles, That you should be for salvation to the ends of the earth.'" Now when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and glorified the word of the Lord. And as many as had been appointed to eternal life believed. And the word of the Lord was being spread throughout all the region. But the Jews stirred up the devout and prominent women and the chief men of the city, raised up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them from their region. But they shook off the dust from their feet against them, and came to Iconium. And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

John 13:31-35

Jesus speaks to His disciples of His upcoming glorification. He gives us a new command---LOVE ONE ANOTHER: AS I HAVE LOVED YOU! Do this not in word only, but in action, motivated by Christ's love for us.

So, when he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now the Son of Man is glorified, and God is glorified in Him. If God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and glorify Him immediately. Little children, I shall be with you a little while longer. You will seek Me; and as I said to the Jews, 'Where I am going, you cannot come,' so now I say to you. A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away.” Then He who sat on the throne said, “Behold, I make all things new.” And He said to me, “Write, for these words are true and faithful.”
