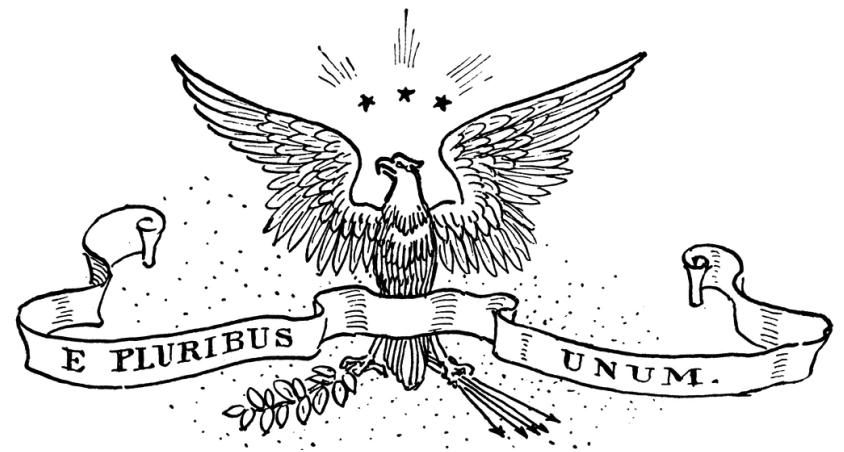
E PLURIBUS UNUM is Latin for “out of many, one.” Sometimes it is translated more loosely as “one from many.” E Pluribus Unum was once the motto of the United States of America and references the fact that the cohesive single nation was formed as the result of the thirteen smaller colonies joining together. E pluribus unum was adopted as a national motto in 1776 and is now found on the Great Seal of the United States and on United States currency.

Fun Facts

- Just as the U.S. has thirteen original colonies, E Pluribus Unum has thirteen letters in it.
- E Pluribus Unum still appears on U.S. coins even though it is no longer the official national motto! The United States Congress gave that honor to In God We Trust in 1956 by an Act of Congress.
- In the 1939 film *The Wizard Of Oz*, the Wizard gives the Scarecrow a Diploma from The Society of E Pluribus Unum.
- E Pluribus Unum, was first used on the 1795 Liberty Cap-Heraldic Eagle gold \$5 piece.

II Corinthians 5:17-21

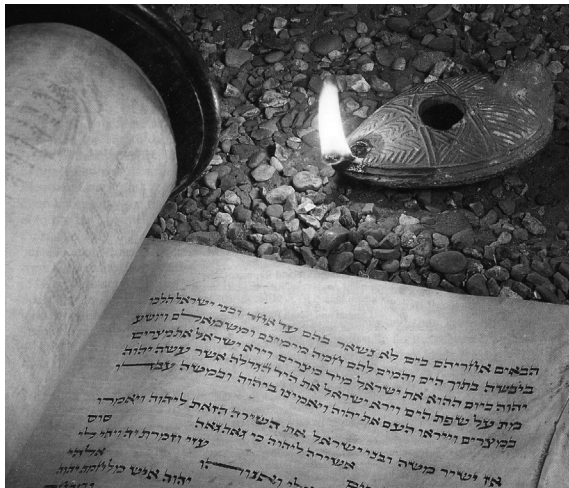
Paul declares that God has reconciled the world to Himself in Christ. That message of reconciliation He has given to us to tell the whole world.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. 18 Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, 19 that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. 20 Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. 21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Jesus encourages us to let our light shine, that is let others see the good works that we do to the glory and praise of God the Father who sent His Son to be our Savior.

"You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? Sermon Text:

Ephesians 4:7-16

Sermon Theme:

**E PLURIBUS UNUM:
OUT OF MANY, ONE!**

I: We are many different people with many different gifts, yet we are all ONE in Christ.

II: As many different people with many different gifts we work for ONE purpose—building up the body of Christ.

But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift. 8 Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, And gave gifts to men." 9 (Now this, "He ascended"—what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? 10 He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.) 11 And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, 13 till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; 14 that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, 15 but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ— 16 from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.
